

Solution to your internet browsers invalid link errors (getting "This link wasn't well formed") when trying open the dropbox.com using the PDF weblinks I have in this post.

Here is solution I found on the internet:

How to fix corrupted DNS cache in windows

Close all open web browsers and applications on your computer.

Open the Windows command prompt by selecting the Start menu and entering cmd in the search text field box followed by clicking the enter key.

At the command prompt, enter ipconfig /flushdns followed by pressing the enter key.

```
C:\>ipconfig /flushdns  
Windows IP Configuration  
Successfully flushed the DNS Resolver Cache.
```

After a moment, Windows will display a message similar to: Successfully flushed the DNS Resolver Cache. Once the message is displayed, the DNS will be flushed removing End of internet information.

My notes on using the above:

You need to type exit (and press the enter key) to quit the cmd session after successfully fixing the DNS issue.

Also I only had to run the ipconfig command once to fix it.
