

ISSUE:

Please be aware that the installation of aftermarket wheels, **particularly wire wheels**, which do not meet original equipment specifications may adversely affect vehicle handling and performance characteristics, and thereby compromise motor vehicle safety. This type of modification could also undermine the dealer's and/or Jaguar Cars' position should the customer file a lawsuit. Also, original equipment Jaguar wheels that have been chromed by aftermarket firms can experience internal corrosion.

For this reason, Jaguar strongly recommends against the installation of **wheels and tires,** that do not meet or conform to original equipment specifications. Owners should be advised that the use of such equipment could adversely affect passenger safety, as well as, the owner's rights under Jaguar's New Vehicle Limited Warranty.

The rectification of problems that arise due to the installation of nonstandard parts, including, but not limited to, ride quality, noise, vibration, and handling complaints, is not covered under any Jaguar warranty. Claims submitted as such will be subject to debit.
