ISSUE

The daytime running lamps feature of S-Type vehicles may be enabled/disabled as a customerrequested option, **except** in markets where daytime running lamps are either mandatory or prohibited. An example of the latter market requirement is Bulgaria.

ACTION:

In markets where disablement of daytime running lamps is mandatory, ensure that this feature is OFF.

Should it be necessary to change the existing setting, the following PDU procedure should be followed:

1.	Locate 627/5 and load into PDU.		
2.	Highlight DIAGNOSTICS.		
3.	Enter VIN.		
4.	Enter VEHICLE FEATURES.
