MAINTENANCE CHECK SHEET

A B MAIN SERVICE (VEHICLE EXTERIOR)

1. Check condition of wiper blades
Check tyre pressures, condition, tread depth, signs of uneven wear and suitability (including spare).

3. Inspect brake pads for wear (disc condition on pad change).
4. Replace Brake Fluid (**Every 2 years**)*

MAIN SERVICE (UNDER BONNET)

5. Renew anti-freeze (**Every 5 years or 150,000 miles**)*
6. 40K Renew air cleaner element
7. 70k Renew spark plugs (**V6**)
8. 100k Renew spark plugs (**V8**)
9. Renew spark plugs (**leaded fuel markets only**)
10. Check accessory drive belt tension wear indicator(s) - replace belt(s) if necessary
11. 150k Renew front accessory drive belt
12. 100k Renew supercharger drive belt (**Supercharged**)
13. Check/top up brake fluid level
14. Check/top up coolant level
15. Check/top up windshield washer reservoir
16. Check/top up power steering fluid level
17. Check/top up battery electrolyte level
18. Renew pollen filter

MAIN SERVICE (UNDER VEHICLE)

19. Renew engine oil and filter
20. Renew oil pan drain plug sealing washer (**V8**)
21. Renew oil pan drain plug assembly (**V6**) - **if necessary**
22. 60k Renew fuel filter element
23. Visually check underbonnet/underbody for any fluid leaks

A B MAIN SERVICE (ROAD TEST)

24. If fault lamp(s) are illuminated, interrogate that system using WDS/IDS and report findings*
25. Carry out road test. During road test ensure to check the following:-
26. Correct operation of gearshift and the lever interlocks
27. Check condition and operation of seatbelts
28. Correct operation of steering lock (if fitted)
29. Correct operation of seat and steering wheel adjust mechanisms
30. The starter motor operates without undue noise and the engine starts easily
31. Correct operation of fault lamps and instruments
32. Check operation of all lamps, horns and warning indicators
33. Check operation of wipers and washers
34. Steering self-centres from left and right hand locks
35. The vehicle does not pull or wander to one side
36. The brakes do not pull to one side but operate smoothly without judder or noise

A B MAIN SERVICE (ROAD TEST)

37. Gear changes are smooth
38. Cruise control engages and disengages correctly
39. Correct operation of climate control system
40. For undue vehicle noises
41. Endorse service record
42. Affix next service reminder sticker
43. Check for any applicable outstanding service actions or recalls
44. Report any unusual features of vehicle condition and additional work required

The maintenance items listed, are those recommended for vehicles operating under normal driving, road and climatic conditions. More frequent attention may be necessary if the vehicle is subject to stop/start operation, extremes of temperature, dusty conditions, off road driving or frequent towing of trailers.

Wiper blades should only be replaced if authority is given by the vehicle owner.

For full details regarding the operations contained in this maintenance check sheet, please refer to the workshop manual.

GLOSSARY:

MAIN SERVICE = The main service is applicable to all vehicles. It is carried out at 12 month or 10,000 mile intervals, whichever occurs first.

Main Service "A" is applicable at 12 months/10,000 miles, 36 months/30,000 miles, 60 months/50,000 miles, 84 months/70,000 miles and so on.

Main Service "B" is applicable at 24 months/20,000 miles, 48 months/40,000 miles, 72 months/60,000 miles, 96 months/80,000 miles and so on. Some items do not need to be carried out at every main service and these items are identified by an indicator in the tick box e.g. 150k (This indicates that this item is only applicable every 150,000 miles)

NOTE: The service required should be at the time or distance stated, **which ever occurs first**. The Service Check Lists may be revised periodically. Franchise holders will be notified of revisions by Service Policy Letters or Technical Bulletins.
