CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE

WINDSOR PARK GATES OPEN AT 9:00am SATURDAY, JULY 24TH

A Concours d'Elegance (from the French meaning a *competition of elegance referring to the gathering of prestigious cars*) is a gathering of automobile owners to have their vehicles, in specifically defined classes and divisions, judged and rated on their appearance.



Under the rules of *Jaguar Car Clubs of North America*, *vehicles* are judged in either 'Champion Division' or 'Driven Division'. In the latter, the engine compartment and boot (trunk) of the cars are not judged and rules regarding authenticity are not as strict as they are for 'Champion Division'. Local scores obtained in both divisions will be rated with scores obtained in other JCNA competitions.

In the 'Enthusiast Division', the vehicles are not judged but are eligible for popular choice awards determined by votes cast by those attending the meet.

Our gorgeous Jaguars will spend the day at Windsor Park, a short drive from our host hotel. Windsor Park features lush green grass, plenty of shade trees, and an adjacent rose garden. Jaguars are <u>all</u> gorgeous, and <u>all</u> are welcome, from the most meticulously restored show car to the most experienced daily driver, from the



very oldest to the newest right out of the showroom. Please don't think your Jaguar might not be "good enough" - we love them all.
