Remote Transmitter Not Functioning – Internal Chip Fault – Replace Transmitter MODEL 2002-04 MY X-TYPE

VIN

C00001-D82662

Issue:

On some 2002-04 MY X-TYPE vehicles, within the above VIN ranges, the transmitter remote may not lock/unlock the vehicle. This condition may be caused by an internal chip fault.

Action:

In case of a customer complaint that the remote transmitter is not locking/unlocking the vehicle, **and there is no fault found with the remote transmitter battery**, supply a new remote transmitter and program it to the vehicle as outlined below.

- 1. Install the new remote transmitter to the key assembly.
- 2. Using Worldwide Diagnostic System (WDS) program the new remote transmitter to the vehicle.

Note: All other functional transmitters programmed to the vehicle are required when carrying out this procedure.
