MAINTENANCE CHECK SHEET

A B MAIN SERVICE (VEHICLE INTERIOR)

1. Replace climate controlled seat cushion motor filters. (where fitted)

A B MAIN SERVICE (VEHICLE EXTERIOR)

2. Check condition of wiper blades
Check tyre pressures, condition, tread depth, signs of uneven wear and suitability (including spare).

4. Inspect brake pads for wear (disc condition on pad change).
5. Replace Brake Fluid (**Every 2 years**)*

MAIN SERVICE (UNDER BONNET)

6. Renew anti-freeze (**Every 10 years or 150,000 miles**)*
7. Renew air cleaner element
8. Renew spark plugs (**V6**)
9. Renew spark plugs (**V8**)
10. Renew spark plugs (**lead fuel markets only**)
11. Check accessory drive belt tension wear indicator(s) - replace belt(s) if necessary
12. Renew front accessory drive belt
13. Renew supercharger drive belt (**Supercharged**)
14. Check/top up brake fluid level
15. Check/top up coolant level
16. Check/top up windshield washer reservoir
17. Check/top up power steering fluid level
18. Check/top up battery electrolyte level
19. Renew pollen filter

MAIN SERVICE (UNDER VEHICLE)

20. Renew engine oil and filter
21. Renew oil pan drain plug sealing washer (**V8**)
22. Renew oil pan drain plug assembly (**V6**) - **if necessary**
23. Renew fuel filter element
24. Visually check underbonnet/underbody for any fluid leaks

A B MAIN SERVICE (ROAD TEST)

25. If fault lamp(s) are illuminated, interrogate that system using WDS/IDS and report findings*
26. Carry out road test. During road test ensure to check the following:-
27. Correct operation of gearshift and the lever interlocks
28. Check condition and operation of seatbelts
29. Correct operation of steering lock (if fitted)
30. Correct operation of seat and steering wheel adjust mechanisms
31. The starter motor operates without undue noise and the engine starts easily
32. Correct operation of fault lamps and instruments
33. Check operation of all lamps, horns and warning indicators
34. Check operation of wipers and washers
35. Steering self-centres from left and right hand locks

A B MAIN SERVICE (ROAD TEST)

36. The vehicle does not pull or wander to one side
37. The brakes do not pull to one side but operate smoothly without judder or noise
38. Gear changes are smooth
39. Cruise control engages and disengages correctly
40. Correct operation of climate control system
41. For undue vehicle noises
42. Reset service indicator (if fitted)
43. Endorse service record
44. Affix next service reminder sticker
45. Check for any applicable outstanding service actions or recalls
46. Report any unusual features of vehicle condition and additional work required

The maintenance items listed, are those recommended for vehicles operating under normal driving, road and climatic conditions. More frequent attention may be necessary if the vehicle is subject to stop/start operation, extremes of temperature, dusty conditions, off road driving or frequent towing of trailers.
