## Sounder for LED flasher systems.



When we introduced our new electronic flasher relay built into the traditional-style alloy can housing recently, the most heard comment was “About time too”. The second most heard comment was “Why doesn’t it make a noise?”.

The fact is, electronic components can be many things:- highly efficient, parsimonious with precious electrical energy and more, but they are silent. Our offerings to replace the traditional “click-clack” of the old-style relays with the noises made by piezo sounders were accepted, in the same way that a boring old uncle at a family gathering is politely, if unenthusiastically tolerated. Driven by this wave of feeling, we grasped greedily at a straw of hope offered by an ingenious and enthusiastic restorer of multiple classics who used his considerable intellect to come up with a solution which works so well that we have taken up his idea.



The new sounder measures just 50mm x 35mm x 22mm and needs only an earth and either a connection to the pulsed output on a conventional flasher system, or to the left and right outputs from the indicator switch on LED systems to make the traditional “click-clack” sound. It has high-tack double-sided tape on the back and can be mounted where you best like the sound. Mount it on a hard surface and it will sound louder. It costs just £29.99+VAT and is now in stock and on the website.
