Wiper blades should only be replaced if authority is given by the vehicle owner. For full details regarding the operations contained in this maintenance check sheet, please refer to the workshop manual.

## GLOSSARY:

MAIN SERVICE = The main service is applicable to all vehicles. It is carried out at 12 month or 10,000 mile intervals, whichever occurs first.

Main Service "A" is applicable at 12 months/10,000 miles, 36 months/30,000 miles, 60 months/50,000 miles, 84 months/70,000 miles and so on.

Main Service "B" is applicable at 24 months/20,000 miles, 48 months/40,000 miles, 72 months/60,000 miles, 96 months/80,000 miles and so on. Some items do not need to be carried out at every main service and these items are identified by an indicator in the tick box e.g. 150k (This indicates that this item is only applicable every 150,000 miles)

NOTE: The service required should be at the time or distance stated, which ever occurs first. The Service Check Lists may be revised periodically. Franchise holders will be notified of revisions by Service Policy Letters or Technical Bulletins.
