

JAGUAR XK8/XKR 2003 – 2006

Pairing your Mobile Phone

1. INTRODUCTION

Jaguar Bluetooth only became available with Model Year 2003. Earlier Model years were offered with a variety of Motorola handsets hardwired to the vehicle.

2. DOES MY VEHICLE HAVE BLUETOOTH?

The only vehicles delivered with Bluetooth as a standard fitment were the Final Series 'Victory' Models in the US and the equivalent 'S' Models in the UK. Bluetooth was available as an optional extra on all other 2003 onwards vehicles.

3. HOW CAN I CHECK?

Difficult! The Audio Units and Steering Wheel buttons look identical regardless of whether the vehicle is equipped with Bluetooth or not. The overhead console **microphone** is also frequently fitted.



The only way to be certain is to check the installed equipment under the centre console



With Bluetooth, the PSEU (Portable Support Electronic Unit) will be connected to the **yellow telephone harness connector**.

4. MY VEHICLE IS EQUIPED WITH BLUETOOTH – CAN I CONNECT MY MOBILE PHONE?

This is the first hurdle. Not all phones will connect to the Jaguar Bluetooth system. A full list of compatible phones can be found at the Jaguar Bluetooth Connectivity Centre:

Enter your VIN to check if your vehicle was factory supplied with Bluetooth. The VIN search is not completely accurate as Bluetooth could have been retro fitted as a dealer option. For this reason the VIN entry is not mandatory to proceed to the check for compatible mobile phones.

Compatible phones are listed by manufacturer and model. Specific instructions for Bluetooth discovery can be downloaded for compatible phones.

5. MY MOBILE PHONE IS COMPATIBLE – HOW DO I PAIR IT WITH THE VEHICLE?

The Bluetooth system operates independently of the vehicle Audio System. It is NOT necessary to have the Audio ON and is actually preferable to switch it OFF before starting the pairing procedure.

NOTE: in the photographs below, I've only moved the gear selector out of PARK to be able to photograph the Audio Unit buttons and display. This is NOT necessary for the pairing procedure.

Your mobile phone should have Bluetooth device discovery activated and the phone switched off before commencing pairing.

Switch the vehicle ignition ON (position II).

1. If the Radio / Cassette / CD is playing, set it to a reasonable volume to be able to hear confirmation beeps during phone pairing.



2. Switch the audio system OFF using the ON/OFF switch and VOLUME control.



3. Press the PHONE MODE button once.



4. The message PHONE or NO PHONE will briefly be shown in the audio unit display.
5. The message SIG will then be shown in the audio unit display.



6. Using the Audio Unit keypad, enter the Discovery Code **##1#*#**



This same code should appear in the Audio Unit display. If it does not appear, proceed to Step 7. If it does appear, go directly to Step 8.

7. Press the C/TA button repeatedly to clear any previously keyed entries. Ten presses should be sufficient.



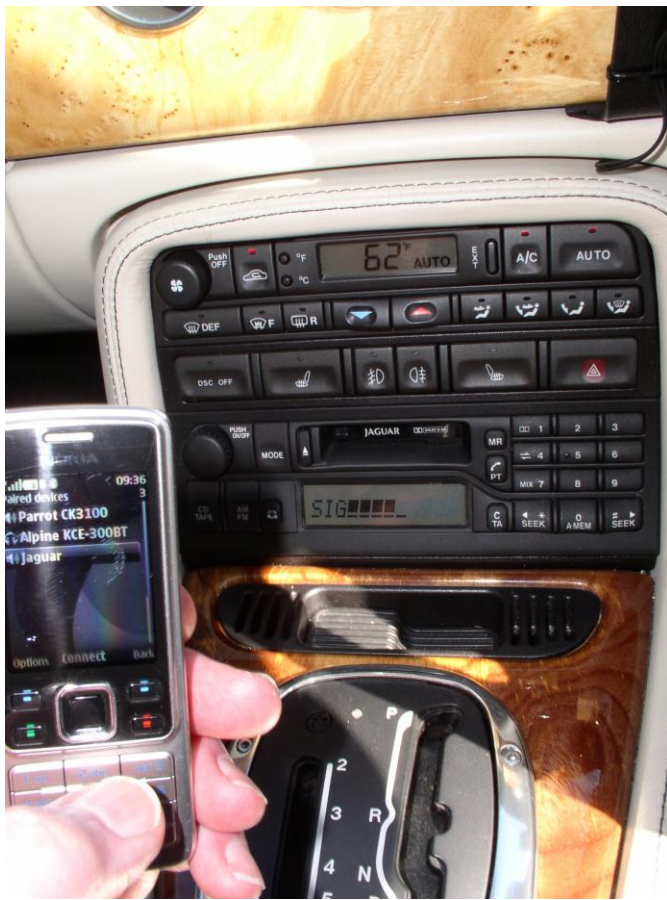
8. Repeat Step 6. If you are still unable to enter the Discovery Code, the system may be locked to the PO's phone. Enter the Disconnect Code **##3##** and press and press the PHONE SEND/END CALL button to disconnect any previously paired phone. Repeat Step 6.
9. With Discovery Code **##1##** visible in the Audio Unit display, press the PHONE SEND/END CALL button.



10. SIG will be displayed.



11. Switch ON your mobile phone and select 'search for Bluetooth devices' from the menu.
12. Select 'Jaguar' from the list of available devices.



13. Enter the Passkey **1313** on your mobile phone keypad.



14. Beeps will be heard over the vehicle speakers as the code is entered and SIG appears in the Audio Unit display.
15. Make a test call by entering the number using the Audio Unit keypad and pressing PHONE SEND/END button. Set the volume level with the steering wheel controls.



16. Press PHONE SEND/END button again to terminate the call.



17. The message CALL ENDED will appear briefly in the Audio Unit display to confirm.

6. NOW IT'S SETUP, HOW DO I CONNECT MY MOBILE PHONE NEXT TIME I USE THE VEHICLE?

This is the first easy part! Provided your phone is switched ON when you start the vehicle, it will automatically connect to the Bluetooth System.

7. LIMITATIONS

Only one mobile phone can be paired with the vehicle at a time. To use another phone, the 'default' phone you've just setup must be disconnected using the **##3##** Disconnect Code and the pairing procedure repeated with the other phone.
